### INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

#### RPL APPLICATION – ADULT STUDENTS ONLY

Recognition of Prior Learning, also referred to as RPL, is an experience, knowledge and skill assessment process that allows you to attain a nationally-recognised qualification or statement/s of attainment, based on skills and knowledge **you will have gained through previous experience** – recognised as either formal training or as informal (i.e. on the job) learning. Students may apply for a full course, Unit of Competency or Cluster of Units as an RPL. **RPL is not recommended for High School students.** An initial RPL is conducted and if any gaps are recognised the training will be done to suit the unit of competency and the applicants. **Gap Units are charged on top of RPL fees.**
